Leray had a dream that he had nurtured since childhood. But after a tragic accident, he knew he never could achieve his life-long goal. Disheartened and bitter, he found himself drifting, with no sense of direction, and adopting destructive habits including alcohol and drug use.

As his life slowly spiraled downhill, he was in and out of jail and couldn't hold a job. "I was unemployed for a good amount of time due to laziness and my criminal record," he says.

Eventually he found himself homeless, staying with anyone who agreed to take him in. When he finally ran out of options – and his family could no longer help him – he came to Dallas LIFE.

"I just wanted shelter, really," he says. But soon, through our Homeless No More Program, he found we offered so much more.

With compassionate counseling and guidance, Leray identified unresolved issues in his life and began to heal emotionally. Through his workforce development task as a security monitor in our shelter, he regained a sense of direction and purpose.

As he opened his mind to new possibilities, he rekindled a passion for cooking, which replaced his shattered childhood dream. Now he hopes to go to culinary school, receive mentoring and tutelage from a chef, and one day have his own food truck.

"Dallas LIFE has given me a chance to take a look at myself, and I've found I have more positives than negatives," he says. "I'm really going to try to make something of myself."

Leray is grateful for the kindness and compassion of loving neighbors like you who've given him peace and hope for the future. "Dallas LIFE has shown me that I'm worth something. I have something to provide in this life and to the world."
