"I was tired of BEING HOMELESS."

As a teen, Zak was introduced to drugs by an older friend, and he used them occasionally until COVID hit. As a result of the pandemic, his job ended and he had time to fill. "Then using became an everyday thing," he says. And it took a dramatic toll on his life.

"When my unemployment ran out and I needed to start working again, I didn't have the will or the will power," he shares. "Becoming a functioning member of society was much harder." His life spiraled downhill, he lost his home and he stayed with whoever would take him in until he wore out his welcome. Finally he found himself on the streets... cold, hungry and alone. "That was the worst part," he recalls.

Then he stumbled upon Dallas LIFE. "It said *Homeless Recovery Center* on the side, and I was tired of being homeless. I wanted a place to stay to get my life back on track."

Now in our care, Zak is harnessing God's strength to overcome his destructive habits. "My spiritual experience and journey are very real to me," he says. Classes including anger management, budgeting

and job readiness are empowering him with skills to regain his independence, and the structure of his daily routine is helping him learn the importance of staying productive and keeping his mind

As he grows healthier physically, mentally and spiritually, Zak has no desire to return to the environment of his past. Instead, he
