

"I became a different man" **

arnest never thought he'd be sleeping behind a trash can, with no one to talk to and no help to be found. He grew up in a Christian family. He had a relationship and a good job. To fall that far was humiliating.

"I was mad at myself. I was supposed to be living like a Christian man, but I felt like I'd failed myself and failed God."

Earnest's mother passed away when he was just 9 years old, and her absence weighed heavily on his emotions. Over the years, addiction was never a problem for Earnest. **Other challenges led to his downward spiral to homelessness:** health trouble and the breakdown of his relationship.

"My back gave out. I had surgery, but I wasn't able to work to care for myself."

From his lowest point of sleeping behind a trash can with a racoon, Earnest arrived at Dallas LIFE. He was humiliated and closed himself off from everyone. Yet, through nutritious meals, safe shelter, Christ-centered counseling and guidance, Earnest's pride melted away. He learned about healthy relationships and how to better manage his finances. He also started reading the Bible and praying every day, and he decided to get baptized.

"I didn't know where my next meal was coming from, so I ended up scavenging on the streets."

"After that I became a different man," he says. "When I came to Dallas LIFE, I was a lost soul, but now I'm changed. The ministry is teaching me how to conduct myself in the real world and what I have to do to succeed.

Earnest is filled with thanksgiving for God's redeeming love in his life – and your incredible generosity and support!"My confidence is higher now. I see the light of Christ in my life, and I know I'm here for a reason. I've learned a lot, and I'm letting God direct my path."
